Bushbuckridge local municipality is a presidential nodal point. The municipality boost a high rate of unemployment hence our dependency on treasury grants to run the municipality. I believe that the business people present here today will take this forum very seriously so that they can play a pivotal role as well in job creation, because together we can create more jobs for our people.

Honourable MEC, on the 01st of June 2011 Bushbuckridge local municipality inaugurated the third democratically elected Council since 2000. - For as long as there are communities without clean water, decent shelter or proper sanitation
- For as long as there are rural dwellers unable to make a decent living from the land on which they live.
- For as long as there are women who are subjected to discrimination, exploitation or abuse
- For as long as there are children who do not have the means nor the opportunity to receive a decent education,

We shall not rest, and we dare not falter, in our drive to eradicate poverty. In pursuit of these goals our government has identified 10 priority areas, which form part of our Medium Term Strategic Framework for 2009 to 2014".

During the Mayoral committee sitting yesterday I said to the committee that our municipal IDP and LED strategy must be consolidated to speak to the needs of our people. I stressed that the current LED strategy must be revisited to ensure that the strategy speaks to all role players in the creation of jobs and sustainable development in Bushbuckridge. To the business people, this is your government come in and be counted as role players in the development of our communities because working together we can create more jobs and free our people from the scourge of poverty.
